Alexandra Bueno grew up between La Paz, Bolivia and Saint Petersburg, Florida. She earned her law degree from Pace Law School, along with an Advanced Certificate in Environmental Law, and is admitted to practice in New York, Florida, and Washington, D.C. Alexandra began her legal career as an Assistant District Attorney in the Domestic Violence Unit at the Suffolk County District Attorney's Office in New York, where she advocated for survivors and worked closely with vulnerable families navigating crisis. Throughout her career, she has worked with government agencies and nonprofit organizations, including the Environmental Protection Agency's New Jersey Superfund Branch and the Pace Environmental Litigation Clinic, experiences that reinforced her commitment to public service. She now serves as the Chief Advocacy Officer at Gulfcoast Legal Services, a nonprofit organization providing free civil legal assistance to low-income individuals and families across the community. In her role, Alexandra focuses on expanding access to justice and strengthening partnerships that support individuals facing civil legal barriers.
